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Elk Grove Unified School District Middle School Expectations

<u>Electronic Devices</u> (Cell phones/Airpods/Headphones etc.) (Handbook page 11-12):

- 1. Devices should be turned off and put way upon before entering front gates.
- 2. Devices that are out during school hours may be confiscated.
 - 1. Parent pick up required

<u>Dress Code Guidelines</u> (Handbook pages 12-13):

- 1. No undergarments showing
- 2. Shorts/skirts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- 3. No "spaghetti straps"
- 4. Shirts must cover midriff (no tummy showing)
- 5. No slippers, slides or wheelie shoes.





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Student Schedules

- Students are receiving **tentative** schedules due to class balancing the first 2 weeks of school and Math Diagnostic results.
- Request Forms available for student pick up in the front office once school starts and are due to counselors no later than Thursday, August 24th (the sooner the better!).
- HEMS has increased the capacity for the number of students who are able to enroll in HONORS classes (ELA/History)
- If you notice a schedule *error*, such as a double class, OR if your child would like to enroll in an Honors course, please contact your student's counselor
- Counselors will process request forms as soon as possible.
- Specific requests are limited due to space/availability BUT requests for teachers and/or periods will not be considered.



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Student Drop Off and Pick Up

Drive-thru in front of school:

- 1. Please pull forward as space is made available along the curb
- 2. No stopping in the 1st lane (by parking spots) or 2nd lane
- 3. Be patient and be aware of students, especially in the crosswalks.

Dismissal:


- 1. Students are expected to leave campus promptly after dismissal.
